Survey Methodology

American Strategies designed and administered this multi-modal survey conducted by professional interviewers and via Qualtrics. The survey reached 412 adults (375 weighted) adults, age 18 or older, who indicated they were registered to vote in Park Township, Michigan. The survey was conducted August 14-21, 2023.

Forty-nine percent of respondents were reached on wireless phones and five percent on VOIP/landlines. Forty-six percent of respondents were reached online. Quotas were assigned to reflect the demographic distribution of Park Township, Michigan, and the data were weighted to ensure an accurate reflection of the population. The sample was drawn from a third-party vendor file. The overall margin of error is +/- 5.1%. The margin of error for subgroups is larger and varies. Percentage totals may not add up precisely due to rounding.
