Welcome to Park Township!

We want you to have a relaxing, enjoyable visit without any surprises. Here are some of the rules around here:

Noise: Quiet hours in Park Township are 11pm to 7am, during which hours noise needs to be kept to a low conversational volume. Please be mindful of your neighbors during daytime hours as well.

Fires: Recreational fires need to be attended at all times, with water or a fire extinguisher on hand. Burning is only permitted on calm days, and must be fully extinguished. Additional rules apply if you are in the Ottawa Beach neighborhood.

Parking: All guests need to park on-site on finished parking surfaces. Lawn parking is not permitted.

Pets: Dogs must be kept on leashes and under control, and owners are expected to remove all animal waste. Please ensure that your animal stays on the property you are renting and off neighboring properties.

Path etiquette: If you're walking or running, stay to the right of the path and make sure you can hear what's going on around you. Move to the right when being passed. If you're biking, please give verbal notice before passing. When passing people walking, slow to running speed and give plenty of room, especially when children are present. Drivers, please remember that path users always have the right-of-way.

Beach and Pier Safety: Lake Michigan is beautiful, but powerful and can be extremely hazardous. Please carefully review the enclosed water and pier safety information. Public beaches in the area do not allow dogs or alcohol.

Fireworks: Fireworks are permitted in Michigan only on certain holidays and hours.

Garbage: Trash needs to be kept in closed trash cans.
